Dear Sir Mota Singh Ji,

Bebe Nanki Istree Sabha

The Bebe Nanki Istree Sabha, was formed on 31st December 2011, at a meeting in Birmingham. Over 50 ladies of the sangat attended the meeting and elected 15 active members to represent Bibi Ji's Ladies Sangat from all areas of the UK. We have a very strong concern for Bebe Nanki Gurdwara and about the existing trustees who are unable to work together on mutual understanding.

We need to meet you to solve the current differences, as requested in our e-mail sent to you on 20th November 2011, via Jaipal Singh.

We need an immediate response to the following:

- 1) Are you still a trustee or have you given a written resignation? If so, when and to who was it sent? No one has any knowledge of your resignation; therefore you are still responsible for Bebe Nanki Gurdwara.
- 2) Was the 24th April 2009 meeting put in abeyance as you have told Mr. Kulwant Singh Ajimal? Why did you request a solicitor's advice? If so, why did you not act on it? Why did you not see it fit to consult the Sangat? Why the two prospective trustees were present at the meeting and why was Sohinder Kaur not informed about what Tarsem Ubhi had said about Kulwant Singh the secretary. You had been warned and informed about the incident involving both Tarsem Singh and Kulwant Singh by Jaipal Singh both verbally and in writing. Mr. Harchand Singh Chanai was too ill to make any decisions as he was at advanced stage of Alzheimers disease. Mrs Sohinder K was almost coerced.
- 3) The trustees who were appointed on 15th Of May 2011 were nominated by the Sangat and trusted by the Sangat except Ubhi, Sagoo and Amritpal.
- 4) We would like you to write a new constitution which should state that the Sangat has the right to nominate the trustees and remove them if need be.

The trustees were/are consistently lacking in their duties of prudence and care in the Gurdwara Sahib building project causing delays and substantial monetary losses. This has led to mistrust of the trustees by the sangat.

House no.213 was demolished causing a loss of asset and income due to neglect and mis-management.

The Gurdwara Sahib building is not fit for purpose due to the following negligence;

- 1)Gurdwara Sahib not having a kitchen is neglect.
- 2) Low ceilings in the prayer hall is neglect.
- 3) Not making provisions for the disabled is neglect.
- 4) Not having wash rooms on all floors is neglect.
- 5) Paying the contractor a large amount of money for a job not done is mis-management and neglect,
- 6) The alterations to the front façade from what the late Bibi Balwant Kaur Ji (the Mahapursh responsible for the Gurdwara Sahib and appointing you a trustee) wanted is sacrilege.

Sir Mota Singh, if you and the other trustees had shown duty, care and trust in the management of the building work, by holding regular meetings with the contractors and keeping the Sangat, who are funding the project, informed this mess and gross loss funds could have been avoided and the Bebe Nanki Gurdwara would have been complete.

Sir, you being the most senior trustee appointed by Bibi Ji must accept responsibility for this mis-management and gross neglect. We demand your leadership to resolve the situation so that there is no more delay and no more waste of Sangat funds, donated for the building and to help the needy.

If no response is forthcoming within 7 days, we will be forced to visit you personally at the House of Lords, unless you decide to meet us at the Bebe Nanki Gurdwara.
